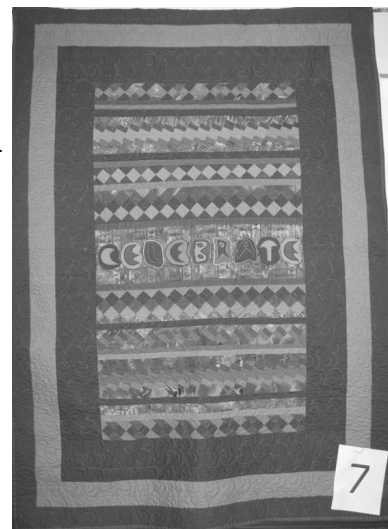

Timberland Reads Together Book Discussion: The Boys in the Boat

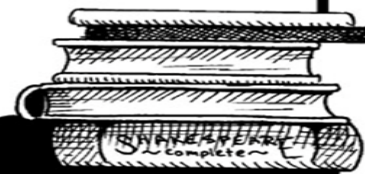
Saturday, October 8 at 2:00pm
