Just before the holiday season in 2018, we asked for your help in raising money to pay for a modest but much-needed remodel of our library. Thanks to the community, we've managed to raise over \$39,000 so far!



With your help, this project will allow us to:

- Replace current service desks with new ADA accessible, barrier-free central service stations.
- •Create a new, separate, dedicated return area to ensure immediate, error-free check in of your materials.
- Create point-of-contact resource stations for community members & staff to engage.
- •Install a fully ADA accessible family restroom with special features to accommodate disabled children, adults & their caregivers.

The costs for this remodel are coming in somewhat higher than the original estimate, so every donation is vital. We need to raise at least \$75,000 to add to funds provided by the City of Lacey and Timberland Regional Library so we can make this project a reality.
